# **Executive Certificate in Foundational Nutrigenomics** and Personalised Nutrition

The different genetic make-up of individuals may affect the efficiency of digestion, absorption and utilisation of certain nutrients. As a result, different persons show different responses to the same food. Nutrigenomics is the science to understand the interaction between nutrients and human genes. The ultimate goal of nutrigenomics is to provide personalised nutrition advice according to one's own genes.

This course aims to equip students with the knowledge of genetics and the cutting-edge technologies to understand how diet interacts with our genes, so as to be able to interpret the test results for personalised nutrition advice.

#### **Admission Requirements**

Applicants shall have:

- 1. A bachelor's degree in Biology, Nutrition and related areas\* awarded by a recognised university; **OR**
- 2. An Associate Degree/ a Higher Diploma in Biology, Nutrition and related areas\* or equivalent, and have at least 2 years of work experience.

All applicants are required to provide evidence of English proficiency, such as

- 1. HKCEE English Language (Syllabus B) at Grade E or English Language (Syllabus A) at Grade C or English Language (in or after 2007) at Level 2; or
- 2. HKDSE Examination English Language at Level 2; or
- 3. Equivalent qualifications

Remarks: \* Degree / Associate Degree / Higher Diploma in other disciplines will be considered on an individual basis.

A HKU SPACE Executive Certificate in Foundational Nutrigenomics and Personalised Nutrition will be awarded to successful candidates.
