If you already hold qualifications with similar learning outcomes to Global MBA modules, you can apply for your prior learning to be recognised and accredited. There are certain qualifications for which we recognise prior learning for exemptions automatically, such as ACCA, CIMA, CFA, CIM.

MODE OF DELIVERY

Intake: April and October (General Intake)

January and July (Accountancy Electives)

Time: Saturday and/or Weekday evening

Duration: 2 years (minimum), 5 years (maximum)



ASSESSMENT

Students will be assessed by a combination of coursework and final examinations or a portfolio. Assessments are marked by the University of London. Students who apply for CEF will be required to submit a short essay for HKU SPACE assessment.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants shall:

- Hold a second-class honours bachelor degree or equivalent from an acceptable institution.
- Have three years' work experience in a managerial role (within the past five years).
- Fulfill the English language requirement.

University of London accepts qualifications from around the world. If applicants have an appropriate professional award rather than a degree, University of London will consider this on an individual basis. For details of entry requirements, please refer to our website.

APPLICATION

To apply for Global MBA Preparatory Courses, applicants must first apply online directly with University of London. After receiving a confirmation email from University of London, a completed application form together with the following documents should be returned to HKU SPACE office in person. - (i) Original and photocopied evidence of your full name and date of birth;
- (ii) Evidence of every qualification listed on application form, including the original certificate(s) and one set of photocopies;
- (iii) Curriculum Vitae / Resume and work reference; and
- (iv) Verification fee of \$350 (non-refundable), which can be paid by cash, EPS and VISA/ Mastercard.

Only registered students may apply to sit for examination and such applications are handled by the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority (HKEAA), not by HKU SPACE.
