Applicants shall:



- 1. Hold a recognized Advanced Diploma or Higher Diploma/ Associate Degree in a business-related discipline awarded within the HKU system through HKU SPACE; OR
- 2A. Hold a recognized Advanced Diploma or Higher Diploma/ Associate Degree in a business-related discipline awarded by a recognized institution; and
- B. Provide evidence of English proficiency, such as
 - i) HKCEE English Language at Level 2; or
 - ii) HKCEE English Language (Syllabus B) at Grade E (Grade C in the case of English Language (Syllabus A)); or
 - iii) HKDSE Examination English Language at Level 2; or
 - iv) an overall band of 6.0 in the IELTS; or
 - v) a score of 500 in the paper-based TOEFL or a score of 173 in the computer-based and a score of 4.5 in the Test of Written English

Mature students (according to University of Plymouth regulation) and applicants with other equivalent qualifications will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Applicants who do not have a business-related academic qualification may be required to take additional module(s) on a case-by-case basis before the start of the programme.

MODE OF DELIVERY

There will be two semesters in an academic year. For each regular module, 15 hours of lectures will be delivered by Plymouth staff in a block weekend, other teaching sessions will be conducted by local lectures on weekday evenings, Saturday afternoons and evenings.
