



On successful completion, you will obtain an **LLB degree awarded by the University of London** and a separate Statement of Attendance issued by HKU SPACE.

#### **University of London LLB**

Students can vary the pace of their studies subject to the programme regulations but must follow the prescribed programme structure.

There is flexibility in the programme structure but students who wish to qualify as lawyers must make sure that they choose the correct modules if they intend to fulfill the admission requirements of the professional training stage (such as the Hong Kong P.C.LL., England and Wales SQE/Bar training course). **The module requirements are different in each jurisdiction.** 

Students aged 18 or above who are ready to study for a degree but do not have the qualifications usually required to enter may apply for the Certificate of Higher Education in Common Law which is a qualification in its own right that also provides an entry route to LLB Study.

\* Students who pass all 4 modules in CertHE may apply to transfer to the Year 2 of the LLB Standard Entry

#### **Entrance Requirements for the 3 Routes**

**Graduate Entry** 

• A degree in a non-law discipline; or equivalent

**Standard Entry** 

- 5 HKDSE Category A subjects at Level 33 (including English Language) + 222 or + 22A; or
- 2 'A' levels and 3 'O' levels (not necessarily obtained in one sitting) or equivalent; or
- Associate Degree or Diploma holders; or equivalent

**CertHE Entry** 

- Aged 18 or above on or before the date of programme registration; AND
- Pass the entrance test and attend an interview; AND
- Demonstrate a good level of English; AND
- Register with HKU SPACE as Recognised Teaching Centre of University of London.

#### Register as UoL LLB Student at University of London (Admissions Office)

Students who wish to take the LLB examinations must also register as overseas students with University of London. The academic year runs from 1 November to 31 October and there are 2 effective dates of registration:

Main-stream application deadline (Full Academic year)

**1 October** (Registration with UoL must be completed by 31 October)

Mid-stream application deadline (Half-term Academic year)

**1 April** (Registration with UoL must be completed by 30 April)

#### TUITION AT HKU SPACE

#### **Enrolment**

Applicants should note that enrolment on the HKU SPACE courses is on a first-come, first-served basis.


Places on the preparation courses are not limited to University of London LLB students and they may well be attractive to those attempting comparable examinations or those who are interested in studying specific modules.

Study visa HKU SPACE Preparation Courses are intended for those having the right to live and study in Hong Kong and it is the responsibility of applicants to determine their eligibility to study. Please refer to "Notes to Non-local Applicants" on the application for enrolment form.

#### **Course Materials, Online Support and Library access**

University of London will provide Module Guides, statute books (where provided), UOL Student Portal Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) and Online Library. It provides free access to the professional legal databases, etc.

HKU SPACE lecturers will provide supplementary materials including lecture outlines, handouts and legal updates. Students on HKU SPACE Preparation Courses will have access to the School's online learning platform (SOUL3.0). Each student will be provided HKU Library Reader's Card, which may be upgraded to Borrower's Card upon paying an extra fee.



#### **University of London Examinations**

There are 2 examination periods in each academic year - May/June and October. In May/June exam, students can sit up to 4 examinations in their first year of study. In October exam, students can sit a maximum of 2 examinations.

The examination syllabus of each year is set out by the University of London in their Law Prospectus. The details will also be given to you when you have the offer from the LLB. Normally, registration for local examinations in Hong Kong shall be done via the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority which is responsible for administering the University of London examinations. #### **Modules/ Credits Recognition and Transfer**

Students may apply to transfer their studies to London, including possible direct entry to Year 2 or even Year 3 of full-time LLB programmes at the University of London, relying on credits earned from studying via HKU SPACE for the University of London Worldwide LLB.

#### **Fees**

University of London Fees Students pay a non-refundable application fee directly to University of London when making their application and a registration fee on completion of registration. A separate module fee is payable for each module and an examination fee for each examination. #### Qualify as Lawyer Around the World

University of London LLB is accepted as a pre-requisite academic qualification to the professional stage in many Common Law jurisdictions. Many of our graduates have been admitted to practise in Hong Kong and England and Wales. There are also graduates who, by relying on the University of London LLB studied with HKU SPACE, are admitted to practise in other jurisdictions.

#### **Hong Kong PCLL**

As the very first formal legal training in Hong Kong dated back to 1960s, the University of London LLB has long been accepted for the purpose of PCLL admission and is among the most welcomed qualifications. Since the LLB is regarded as a non-local legal qualification, holders will need to take PCLL admission conversion exams to obtain full eligibility. But following HKU SPACE study plan and with HKU SPACE own prep courses for the conversion exams, London students studying with HKU SPACE are always best supported. #### **England and Wales**

#### **SQE**

The Solicitors Qualifying Examination (SQE) opens to degree holders in any subject intending to be qualified as solicitors. But a prestigious formal law degree still puts you in a better position and is likely to be favoured by law firms. A rigorous LLB will give you solid foundation to pass the SQE assessments. SQE includes two assessments: SQE1 and SQE2. SQE1 assesses functioning legal knowledge (FLK). Most of the FLK areas are covered in the LLB curriculum. #### **Bar training**

You still need a qualifying law degree (minimum 2:2 classification) or a non-law degree plus a Graduate Diploma in Law to fulfill the academic stage if you want to become a barrister. Your law degree must include seven foundations of legal knowledge which are all covered in the LLB curriculum. For full details, please refer to the Bar Standards Board:

#### **TUITIONS AT HKU SPACE**

[Note 1] Students of Standard Entry Route must register "Legal System and Method" in your first year.

[Note 2] Level 5 Tort Law Examination can only be taken by Year 1 students who are also taking all three Level 4 modules under the Graduate Entry Route, namely the 'Fast Track Route'. Year 1 students who take the Fast Track Route will have to sit all 4 exams at the first attempt in the May/June assessments.

#### **Preparation Courses Structures**

Main lectures run from October to January and revision lectures run from March/April. There will be lectures focusing on exam preparation and writing skills, and students will have an opportunity to submit written work in advance of these lectures. Mock Exams will be held in February/March.

Our London U LLB preparation courses are not limited to University of London LLB students. Students who are attempting English Law or comparable examinations or those who are interested in studying specific modules are also welcome.


