Mode of **Delivery**

There will be two semesters in an academic year. Students will normally take 3 modules in each semester. For each regular module, 15 or 30 hours of lectures will be delivered by Plymouth staff in a block weekend, others by local teachers on either weekday evenings or Friday evenings, Saturday afternoons / evenings. All lectures of enhancement modules will be delivered by local teachers. Students are required to pass all 7 modules in order to graduate. Students may complete this programme in a minimum of 1.5 years and a maximum of 5 years.

Entry Requirements

Applicants shall:

- a) hold a recognised Professional Diploma or Higher Diploma in the discipline of logistics, transport, shipping, operations, or trade awarded within the HKU system through HKU SPACE or from other recognised institutions; AND
- b) have 2 years of full-time work experience in the area of logistics, transport, shipping, operations or trade.

If the above academic qualification is from an institution where the language of teaching and assessment is not English, applicants shall provide evidence of English proficiency such as:

- i) an overall band of 6.0 in the IELTS (with minimum component scores of 5.5 in all four components: listening, reading, speaking and writing); or
- ii) an overall score 76 or above in the TOEFL iBT (with minimum component scores of listening 17, reading 18, speaking 20, writing 18)

Applicants may be required to take and pass additional module(s), based on individual merit, before the start of the programme.

Applicants with other equivalent qualifications will be considered on individual merit.
