ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants shall:

- 1.a) have gained in the HKALE Grade E in one AL subject or two AS subjects or hold a post-secondary qualification of at least one year part-time duration; and
- b) have gained in the HKCEE Grade E in four subjects, and Level 2 in English language*; and
- c) have at least two years of full-time work experience in logistics, transport, or business related areas; or
- 2.a) have gained in the HKDSE Examination five subjects passed at Level 2, including English Language; and
- b) have at least two years of full-time work experience in logistics, transport, or business related areas.
- 3. have gained a Certificate or Advanced Certificate awarded within the HKU system through HKU SPACE.

Applicants with other equivalent qualifications and relevant work experience will be considered on individual merits.

* With effect from 2007, HKU SPACE recognises Grade E previously awarded for Chinese Language and English Language (Syllabus B) (Grade C in the case of English Language (Syllabus A)) at HKCEE as an acceptable alternative to Level 2 in these two subjects at HKCEE

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

These 3 programmes are structurally designed for those who wish to pursue a higher level of academic qualification and professional recognition in the logistics and related areas, in order to improve their career advancement prospect in the industry. Objectives
