Postgraduate Diploma in Sport and Recreation Management

Introduction


The Postgraduate Diploma in Sport and Recreation Management aims to prepare senior sport and recreation specialists by developing specific sport and recreation management skills and unique theoretical foundations from an international standpoint. During the programme students will engage with recreation and sport organisations that have a global connection and will need to apply sport and recreation management principles and construct solutions in an international context. It will be suitable for those who are currently working in sport and recreation organisations or who aspire to work in this exciting and growing global industry.

Programme Structure


The entire HKU SPACE programme is normally completed in nine months of part time study in Hong Kong. Each of the five modules comprises 40 hours of teaching extended over 14 sessions. Classes normally commence in September and January each year. Normally students should attend class two times per week in the evening (7pm – 10pm).

Teaching and Assessment

All modules will be taught through face-to-face classes conducted by HKU SPACE lecturers who are qualified academic and professional staff with extensive teaching experience at tertiary level.

The programme incorporates a wide variety of assessment methods enabling the ways in which student achievement is measured and evaluated to be appropriate to the learning outcomes of each module. Each taught module will be assessed on the basis of coursework (100%) and the pass mark is set at 50%.



Entry Requirements

Applicants shall hold a degree from a recognized institution in an appropriate subject, for example sport, social sciences, management or business, or equivalent.

If the degree or equivalent qualification is from an institution where the language of teaching and assessment is not English, applicants shall provide evidence of English proficiency such as:

- i. An overall band of 6.0 or above with no subtests lower than 5.5 in the IELTS;
- ii. HKALE Use of English at Grade E or above; or
- iii. Equivalent qualifications

Consideration will also be given to mature applicants who do not fulfill the academic requirement but who can demonstrate extensive industrial experience in positions requiring senior management skills. Such applicants shall have to provide evidence of English proficiency such as an overall band of 6.0 in the IELTS, or equivalent. Applicants with other qualifications will be considered on individual merit.
