For example, where the employees need strong English skills to perform their role effectively, but does not need specialist business terminology. 

SPACE English Language

The SPACE General English programme consists of 7 tiers with each becoming progressively more difficult. Each tier leads to its own academic awards, spanning from Foundation Certificate to Advanced Diploma in General English awarded within the HKU System through HKU SPACE.

Upon completion of each tier, students may progress to the next level programme by meeting the minimum entry requirements for admission to the specific programme.

Our overall aim is to give students on-going practice of language skills at an appropriate level of proficiency. Under the guidance of very well-qualified and experienced teachers, students are equipped with English knowledge and skills through language practice and student-centred learning activities such as small group discussion, reading, writing, speaking and listening to a wide variety of authentic and semi-authentic language texts.

SPACE General English Entrance Examination



The SPACE General English Entrance Examination is used to place applications into suitable English courses within a seven-tier General English Programme at HKU SPACE. Students can begin at any level, from foundation certificate to advanced diploma level. The entrance examination is offered at specific times every year: from August to October for the autumn intake, and from February to March for the spring intake.

Please pay the General English Entrance Exam Fee (HK\$210) before the test which starts at 10:30am on Saturday (20 February). The Test Fee (HK\$210) will be refunded to those who enrol into a General English course on the same day ie Saturday 20 February 2021.

A non-refundable fee of \$210 is required for taking this test. Applicants for the test should fill out the special application form for the SPACE General English Entrance Examination to take the exam on a date that suits them. We will send out admission letters offering places after the exam sessions in good time to allow applicants ample time for course enrolment. Applicants who take an early exam will have a better chance of getting a place at a centre and time of their choice. Applicants who take a later exam will have a limited choice of classes.

There is no guarantee that everyone who takes the SPACE General English Entrance Examination will be offered a place in any of the tiers of the SPACE English Course. Candidates with examination performance below the Certificate in General English (Foundation) may be advised to take the Essential English course before continuing with higher level English language development programmes at HKU SPACE.

Candidates for SPACE General English Entrance Examination should note:

- (1) Unless any change is made to the announced details, NO admission form will be issued.
- (2) Candidates with official receipts should go to the exam session of their choice at the registered time and place.

(3) No refunds or transfers to a different exam session will be approved.

Non-Local Applicants / Non-Permanent Hong Kong Residents should note:

The following non-local / non-permanent Hong Kong residents are eligible to study part-time English Language courses at HKU SPACE without making visa arrangements (they do not need prior approval before taking up part-time study courses):

- 1 those who live in Hong Kong on one-way permits (單程證);
- 2 those admitted to Hong Kong as dependents;
- 3 those issued with a valid working/employment visa; and
- 4 those who stay in Hong Kong under the Capital Investment Entrant Scheme.

It is the responsibility of individual applicants to ensure that their visas are valid and to make appropriate visa arrangements. Upon course enrolment, non-local applicants are required to show original copies of their permits and/or visas during application of General English programmes.




