The Postgraduate Diploma in Business Management aims to equip current and potential business leaders and senior managers with knowledge and competencies appropriate to a leadership role in business management. The programme adopts a practical approach with the goal of preparing students with the skills to address the managerial issues in an increasingly changing environment.

R Applicant shall:

- hold a bachelor's degree awards by a recognized institution; OR
 - hold a professional qualification in a relevant discipline and three years of full-time work experience at senior managerial level in related industries.
- If the degree or equivalent qualification is from an institution where the language of teaching and assessment is not English, applicants shall provide evidence of English proficiency, such as:
- i. an overall band of 6.0 or above with no subtests lower than 5.5 in IELTS; or
 - ii. a score of 550 or above in the paper-based TOEFL, or a score of 213 or above in the computer-based TOEFL, or a score of 80 or above in the internet-based TOEFL; or
 - iii. HKDSE Examination English Language at Level 3 or above; or
 - iv. HKALE Use of English at Grade E or above; or
 - v. equivalent qualifications.
- * Applicants not meeting the standard set of criteria for admission will be considered on individual merit.

A part-time top-up degree programme aims to ensure that students will develop a broad understanding of the complex, diverse and dynamic business environment for management. The programme curriculum is both international and practical in its contents. Students will acquire management skills as well as intellectual capability that enable them to perform effectively as a practicing manager. Thus, enhances their employability and facilitate career management.

R Applicants shall:

- A) (i) hold a recognized Advanced Diploma or Higher Diploma / Associate Degree in a business-related discipline awarded within the HKU system through HKU SPACE;
or
(ii) a) hold a recognized Advanced Diploma or Higher Diploma / Associate Degree in a business-related discipline awarded by a recognized institution; and
b) provide evidence of English proficiency, such as:
- HKCEE English Language at Level 2; or
- HKCEE English Language (Syllabus B) at Grade E (Grade C in the case of English Language (Syllabus A)); or
- HKDSE Examination English Language at Level 2; or
- an overall band of 6.0 in the IELTS; or
- a score of 500 in the paper-based TOEFL or a score of 173 in the computer-based and a score of 4.5 in the Test of Written English

AND

- B) Preferably have 2 years full-time work experience or 4 years part-time work experience.

Mature students (according to University of Plymouth regulation) and applicants with other equivalent qualifications will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Applicants who do not have a business-related academic qualification may be required to take additional module(s) on a case-by-case basis before the start of the programme.

R Applicants shall:

1. 2 HKDSE Category A subjects at Level 3 (including English Language) and 3 HKDSE Category A subjects at Level 2 (including Mathematics); or
2. (a) 2 GCE 'A' Level Grade E + 3 GCE 'O' Level Grade C (including English Language & Mathematics); or
- (b) 2 HKAL Grade E + HKCEE English Language at Grade C & 2 subjects at Grade E in HKCEE (including Mathematics); or
3. International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma including Mathematics / Mathematical Studies at Grade 3 (Higher Level / Standard Level); or
4. An Associate Degree / a Higher Diploma from HKU SPACE or other recognised awarding institutions.
