The programme aims to equip the students with necessary engineering knowledge and technical competencies to solve problems and make engineering decisions in the construction processes of complex building projects.

Notes: *It is the applicants responsibility to confirm with the relevant professional institution his/her eligibility for application of the professional membership.

R Applicants should:

- hold a bachelor's degree in building discipline awarded by a recognized university; AND
 - provide evidence of English proficiency if the degree or equivalent qualification is from an institution where the language of teaching and assessment is not English, such as:
 - an overall band of 6.0 or above with no subtests lower than 5.5 in the IELTS; or
 - a score of 550 or above in the paper-based TOEFL, or a score of 213 or above in the computer-based TOEFL, or a score of 80 or above in the internet-based TOEFL; or
 - HKALE Use of English at Grade E; or
 - HKDSE Examination English Language at Level 3; or
 - equivalent qualifications.

R Applicants shall:

- a) (i) hold a degree or equivalent in an appropriate subject, for example construction, transport, logistics or healthcare; or
 - (ii) hold appropriate professional qualifications, for example the National Examination Board in Occupational Safety and Health (NEBOSH) Diploma, or registered safety officer recognized by the HKSAR, or equivalent, with professional experience in the occupational safety and health (OSH) field; and
- b) provide evidence of English proficiency such as IELTS with a minimum score of 6.0 or TOEFL with a minimum score of 550, or equivalent. Applicants, who do not satisfy the minimum English proficiency requirement, may be required to attend an interview or take an English enhancement course.
