The programme targets at those who want to develop a career in the museum and related sectors based on leading museum studies research and practice.

R Candidates should have:

- a first or second class honours degree from a recognized university; AND
- a) an overall score of 6.5 in IELTS or a score of 90 for the TOEFL IBT test, taken within the last two years; OR
- b) HKALE Use of English at Grade C or above; OR
- c) HKDSE Examination English Language at Level 4 or above; OR
- d) Leicester English Test (LET) passed.

In recognition of the diverse employment needs of the culture sector, the admissions committee recognises and credits a range of prior qualifications and experiences.

Prospective candidates will either have gained a first class or second class degree, which can be in any subject area, or be able to demonstrate equivalent skills and aptitudes through the possession of a professional or vocational qualification and/or the accrual of relevant work experiences. Relevant experience can come from a wide spectrum of work or voluntary environments but clear evidence of this experience must be provided.

All candidates should be able to demonstrate a commitment to, or strong interest in, museums, galleries, or other kinds of heritage or cultural organisation.

Candidates without a degree will be asked to complete an assessment, such as an essay, so as to demonstrate your readiness for postgraduate study. Clear guidance will be provided on the assessment criteria. You may also be required to attend an interview.

- hold a bachelor's degree in Art, Design, Humanities, Social Sciences, Business, or other areas of Creative Practice such as performance, or equivalent, awarded by a recognised institution; AND
 - have at least two years of relevant work experience.

Applicants with qualifications from a university or comparable institution within/outside Hong Kong where the language of teaching or assessment is not English, are required (unless exceptionally exempted) to obtain a score of 7.0 in IELTS (with a minimum of 5.5 in each sub-test); or to obtain a score of 100 in TOFEL iBT (with a minimum of 20 in each sub-test).

We anticipate that the programme will also appeal to candidates with business management and administration backgrounds whose careers have led to direct engagement with creative processes and events or who wish to move into the cultural and creative sectors.
