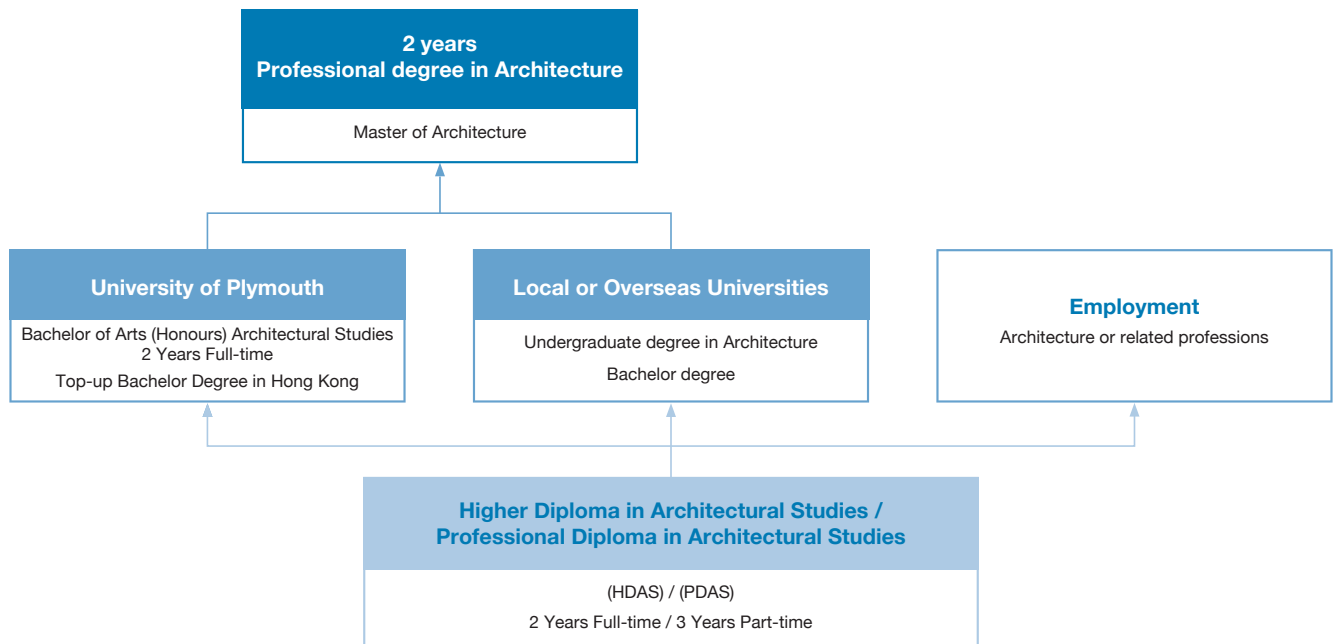

The Professional Diploma in Architectural Studies programme of HKU SPACE has been launched since 1998. It is a part-time three-year programme with two exit points that targets mainly mature applicants with full-time job who are interested in the architecture profession or wished to make a career change.

The programme introduces the latest digital technology such as Building Information Modelling (BIM) as a teaching and design tool, in addition to the traditional media of physical model making and hand renderings, students will be equipped with the advanced knowledge and skills in architectural technology and professional practice. As their studies progress, they will have the ability and be given opportunities to work on design projects and collaborations, and to develop contact with the architecture field and construction industry.

The programme offers students comprehensive training to become architectural assistants capable of supporting the local building industry and other allied professions, as well as further articulation into the tertiary education in architecture.

R Applicants shall:

- have gained in the HKDSE Examination* Level 2 or above in five subjects including English Language, Chinese Language and Mathematics (Core) and with 1 year's relevant working experience; or
- have a pass in one AL subject or two AS subjects in the HKALE; or
- hold a recognised Pre-Associate Degree / Foundation Programme qualification; or
- hold a recognised post-secondary certificate, diploma or degree.

Applicants with other qualifications will be considered on individual merit.

Applicants who do not possess the above academic qualifications but who are aged 25 or above with 1 year's relevant working experience will be considered by the College.

This programme aims to introduce students to the running of architectural practice in Hong Kong and the different roles played by an architect. In addition, the course provides students with a basic understanding of the role of architects in the building process of getting a building built in Hong Kong. It will also provide an in-depth look at the statutory and non-statutory control on building design, contractual aspects of building construction and architect's specification writing.

Ethical and legal obligations and various aspects that an architect can be held liable in practice arising, his role with the client and between employer and employee. Students would be made to understand how to take responsibilities when they qualify as professionals in the context of real problems and dealing with buildings.

Prior applicants included structural engineers, property agents, building surveyors, etc.

R Applicants shall:

- have gained in the HKDSE Examination* Level 2 or above in five subjects and with 2 year's relevant work experience in an architectural practice or in the construction industry;

or

- have a pass in two HKALE subjects;

or

- hold a recognized post-secondary certificate, diploma or degree.

Equivalent qualifications will be considered by the College.

Applicants who do not possess the above academic qualifications but who are aged 25 or above with 1 year's relevant working experience will be considered by the College.

The Postgraduate Certificate in Building Engineering aims to equip students necessary engineering knowledge and technical competencies to solve problems and make engineering decisions in the construction processes of complex building projects.

The programme is an approved top up course in meeting the academic requirements for the Corporate Membership in the Building Discipline of the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers (HKIE)*.

The programme is designed for part-time study of around 6 months. Classes will normally be scheduled for two weeknights per week, from 7:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m.. In addition to normal lectures, there are non-lecture activities such as laboratory sessions that may be scheduled on weekends

* It is the applicant's responsibility to confirm with relevant professional institution(s) his/her eligibility for application of the professional membership(s).

R Applicants shall:

(1) (a) hold a bachelor's degree in the building discipline awarded by a recognized university; or
(b) have gained a pass in the Chartered Institute of Building (CIOB) Part II Examination.

AND

(2) provide evidence of English language proficiency if the degree or equivalent qualification is from an institution where the language of teaching and assessment is not English, such as:
i. an overall band of 6.0 or above with no subtests lower than 5.5 in the IELTS; or
ii. a score of 550 or above in the paper-based TOEFL, or a score of 213 or above in the computer-based TOEFL, or a score of 80 or above in the internet-based TOEFL; or
iii. HKALE Use of English at Grade E; or
iv. HKDSE Examination English Language at Level 3; or
v. Equivalent qualifications.

(3) have at least two years of relevant work experience in the construction industry.
