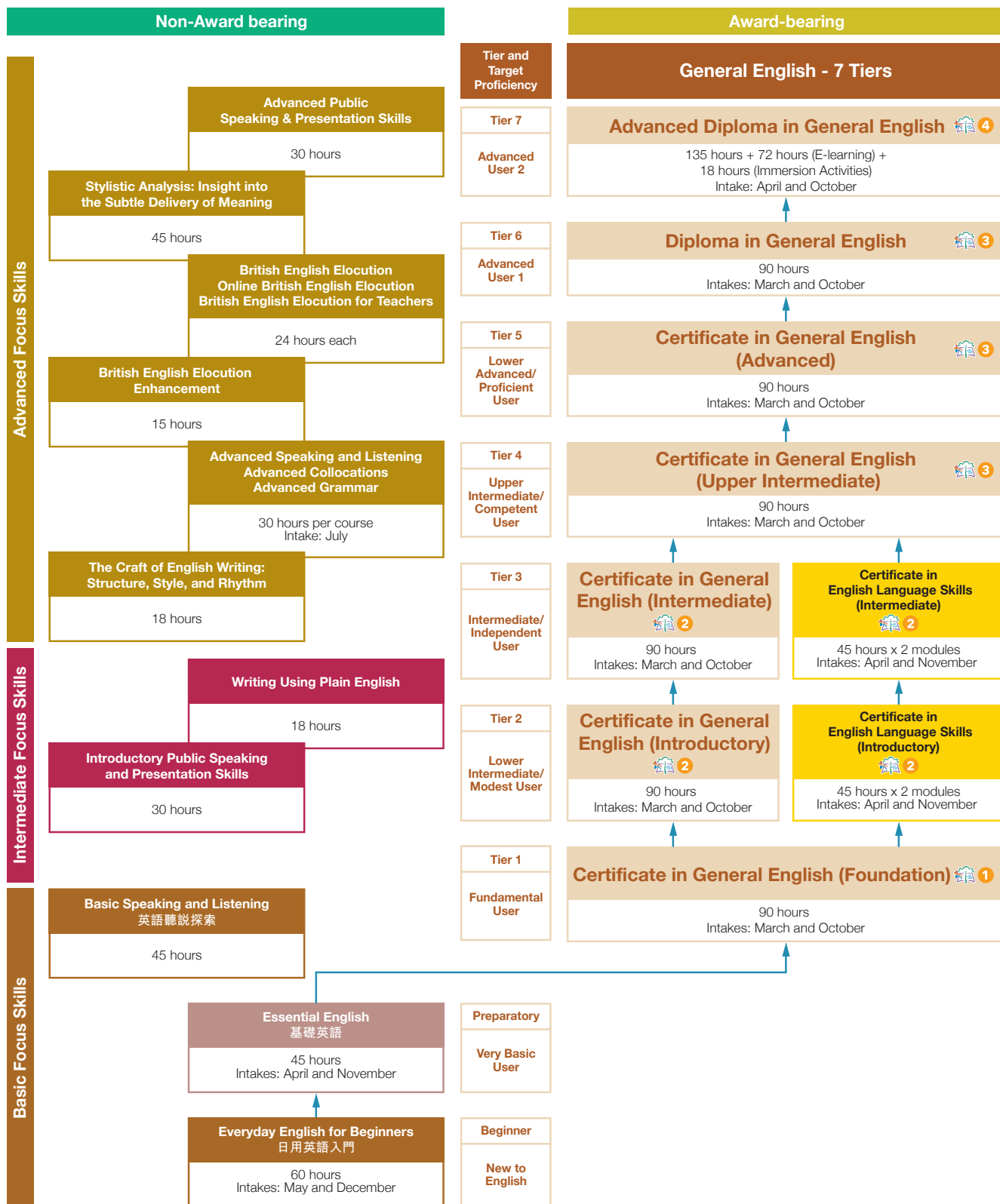

## HKU SPACE English for Academic Purposes (EAP) and Professional and Business English (PBE)



### General English Programmes

The SPACE General English programme consists of 7 tiers with each becoming progressively more difficult. Each tier leads to its own academic awards, spanning from Foundation Certificate to Advanced Diploma in General English awarded within the HKU System through HKU SPACE.

Upon completion of each tier, students may progress to the next level programme by meeting the minimum entry requirements for admission to the specific programme.

Our overall aim is to give students on-going practice of language skills at an appropriate level of proficiency. Under the guidance of very well-qualified and experienced teachers, students are equipped with English knowledge and skills through language practice and student-centred learning activities such as small group discussion, reading, writing, speaking and listening to a wide variety of authentic and semi-authentic language texts.

### Advanced Diploma in General English

This programme is designed for students who seek to advance knowledge of the English language system and develop higher language awareness and communication skills. Apart from face-to-face learning in the classroom, students participate in self-directed and experiential learning outside the classroom, i.e., e-learning and English Immersion Activities.

The programme aims to:

- provide students of advanced English proficiency with opportunities to further improve linguistic knowledge and functional language use through conveying ideas on information-rich topics and in a variety of contexts; and
- enable students to make further advancement in English proficiency through improved linguistic competence and an increased awareness of English as an international language.

The programme is a 60-credit course with a total of 135 face-to-face lecture hours and 90 non-lecture hours on:

- E-Learning Activities: 72 hours
- English Immersion Activities: 18 hours

Students are required to spend additional time and efforts in completing the assigned E-learning and English Immersion activities.

Incorporated with a coursebook, Everyday English for Beginners uses Content and Language Integrated Learning (CLIL) approach to teach student basic vocabulary, grammar, and common phrases for daily conversation. This course is suitable for students who have limited English language skills.

The SPACE Focus Skills courses can be taken either individually as stand-alone courses, or as part of the Certificate in English Language Skills (ELS) (Introductory or Intermediate). ONLY students with successful certificate attainment are eligible to CEF Claims.

Though restricted to specific language skills, these modules will help students become more fluent and confident when communicating in English. After attaining the Certificate in English Language Skills (Introductory and/or Intermediate), students progress to our higher level SPACE General English Programme with equivalent recognition.

### British English Elocution Series

#### British English Elocution

Programme Code: GENG9120



This short course is specially designed for advanced English speakers who wish to improve their professional image by modifying their accent to sound more like a native British English speaker. We help you to achieve Standard English pronunciation of words (based on learning and practising the 'correct' vowel and consonant sounds), together with Standard English rhythm, stress, intonation, and tone. These are what is generally meant by "accent".

Learners will typically be employed or possess an interest in journalism, public relations, marketing, media and communications, but motivated applicants in other fields will be considered.

The determined student should finish with an understanding of his/her pronunciation 'issues' and of how to modify his/her accent over time, after the course has finished. For clarity, British English Elocution is not a public speaking course for speechmakers.

**R** Applicants should be graduates and willing to take part in discussions and practical reading aloud and speaking exercises, ideally with little inhibition. They should be reasonably confident and fluent English speakers.

Applicants should note that it takes self-awareness and persistence to permanently modify one's speaking accent.

Exploring forms, practices, and politics of representation, we will discuss the importance, as well as the futility, of representational ethnic struggles.
